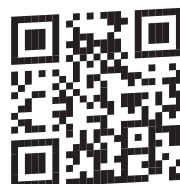

**Pécs Summer School
2026**

The university offers the following two- and four-week summer programs:

European Studies

July 4–18

The aim of the course is to help students understand the political, economic, cultural and social accomplishments and challenges of the European Union, as well as to learn about the contributing factors that led to contemporary Europe.

Who should apply: Undergraduate, graduate and PhD students

Program fee: 1050 EUR

Earned credits: 6 ECTS credits

Leadership Skills

July 4–18

This intensive two-week summer course empowers participants with essential leadership skills to guide and inspire teams effectively. Participants will explore key concepts of leadership, including vision setting, strategic thinking, communication, team dynamics, and decision-making.

Who should apply: Undergraduate, graduate and PhD students

Program fee: 1050 EUR

Earned credits: 6 ECTS credits

Sustainability – Social Ecology

July 4–18

This program combines lectures with hands-on experience to explore social ecology and the interconnection of social and environmental systems. By working with local NGOs, including a Community Garden and an NGO for disabled students, participants gain practical insight into building sustainable and inclusive communities.

Who should apply: Undergraduate and graduate students

Program fee: 1050 EUR

Earned credits: 6 ECTS credits

International Human Rights Law

July 4–18

The summer school will address some of the most typical issues of international human rights, including the protection of human rights in armed conflicts and the accession of the EU to the European Convention on Human Rights. The debate course will provide students with an introduction to argumentation theory, rhetoric, and practical skill-building exercises in debate and public speaking.

Who can apply: Law students

Program fee: 1450 EUR

Credits offered: 6 ECTS credits

Debate Academy

July 19 – August 2

The program provides students with an introduction to argumentation theory, rhetoric, and practical skill-building exercises in debate and public speaking. The theories discussed in the course are connected to present-day issues and students' personal research interests.

Who should apply: Undergraduate, graduate and PhD students

Program fee: 1050 EUR

Earned credits: 6 ECTS credits

4-week program

July 5 – August 2

You can combine the European Studies, Leadership Skills, International Human Rights Law or Sustainability program with the Debate Academy for a 4-week experience. The credits and program fees of both programs will be added together.

All summer programs are facilitated in English.

Deadline of application: April 1, 2026

All the program fees include:

- cost of instruction
- accommodation in a dormitory
- lunch on teaching days
- dinner when evening programs are organized
- sightseeing, museum visits, Intercultural Evening, Quiz Night, wine tasting program, dragon boat competition, and darts contest
