Each program consists of several different courses, and one course represents between 2-9 ECTS credits per semester. The University of Pécs provides all assistance necessary for credit transfers.



Accommodation

Incoming study abroad students are offered a placement in dormitories where they live in a multicultural environment with other international and Hungarian students. The dormitories have recently been refurbished and meet all the requirements of students. Rent is approximately 310 USD/month.

Affordable Study Abroad Experience

The tuition fees for the study abroad programs are either program-based with a fixed fee, or credit-based, depending on the chosen area of study. Students from partner universities can benefit from a reduced tuition fee. The tuition fees for each of the study areas are as follows:

Program-based Tuition Fees

In these programs, applicants can enroll in 3-5 courses. Courses from different academic disciplines and faculties can be combined for the same fee.

Credit-based Programs Fees

In these programs, applicants are asked to take a minimum of 20 ECTS credits worth of courses. The courses for these programs cannot be combined with courses from other programs.

Student Life

Students are the heart and soul of Pécs, and university life on campus is energetic and lively. The Student Union organizes regular dance parties, concerts, quiz nights, hikes, spa nights, and special events such as the International Evening, the University Days and excursions to tourist destinations. During the International Seasons program, unique intercultural events are organized throughout the year. A wide range of sporting opportunities is also offered to support international students.

The city offers a wide variety of cultural activities such as concerts, art exhibitions, theatre performances, and dance shows. The city of Pécs was awarded the European Capital of Culture in 2010.

Fall semester: from September until January

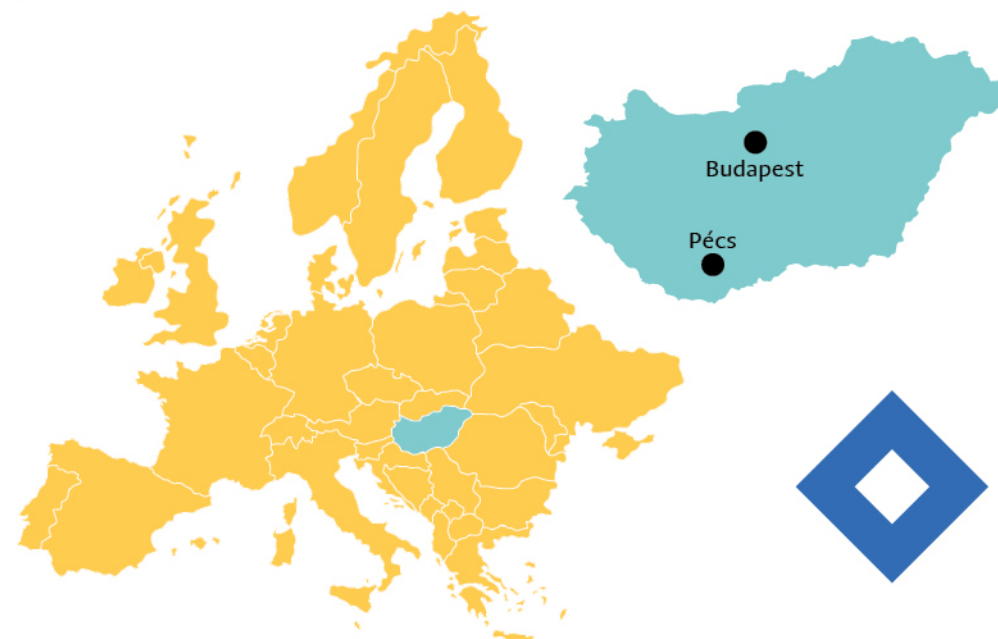
Spring semester: from February until June
