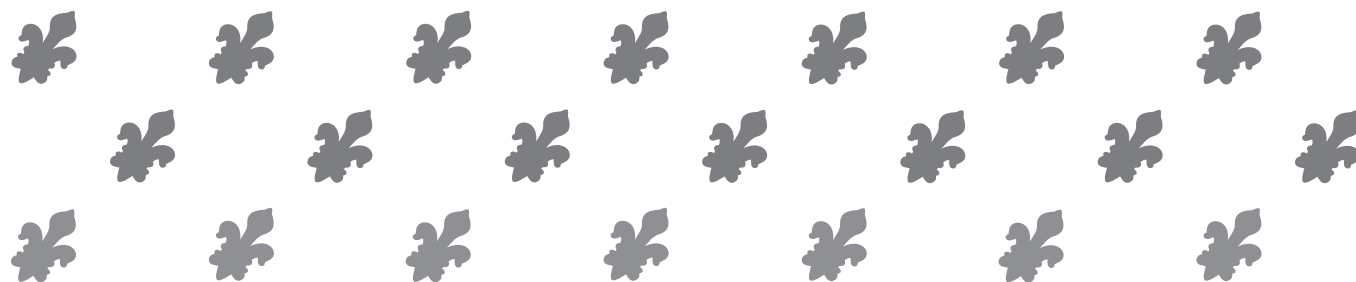

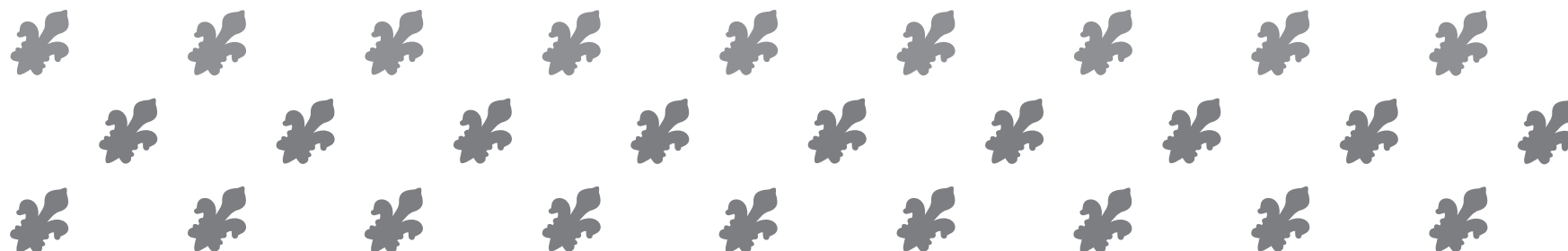

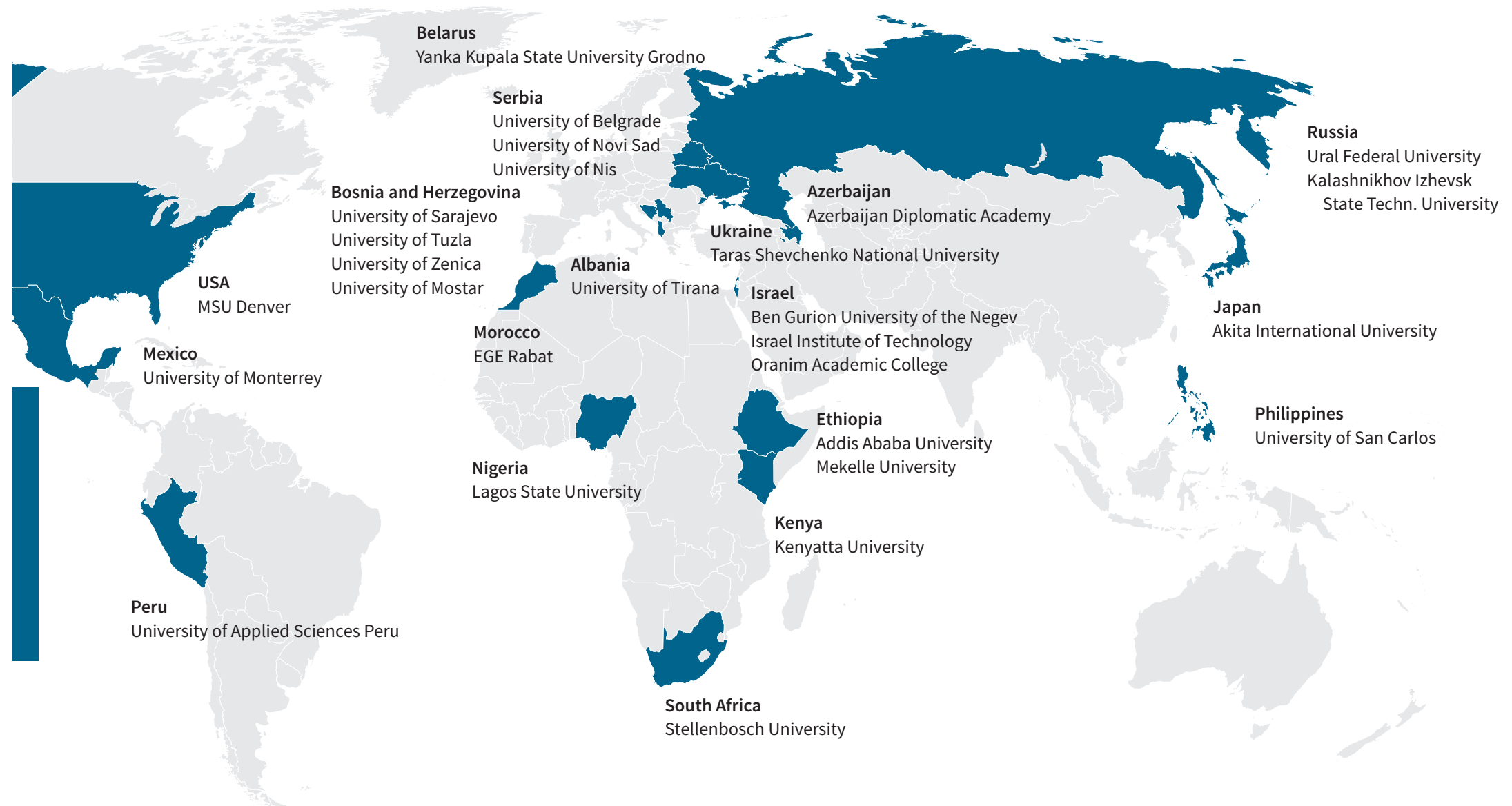

The University of Pécs, as programme country institution, is expected to implement 190 individual mobility opportunities (incoming/outgoing student and teaching staff) in two consecutive project periods (2018-20 and 2019-21) with 27 partner institutions from 18 countries. 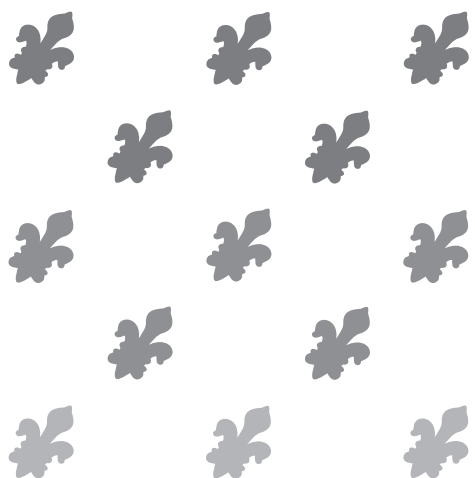

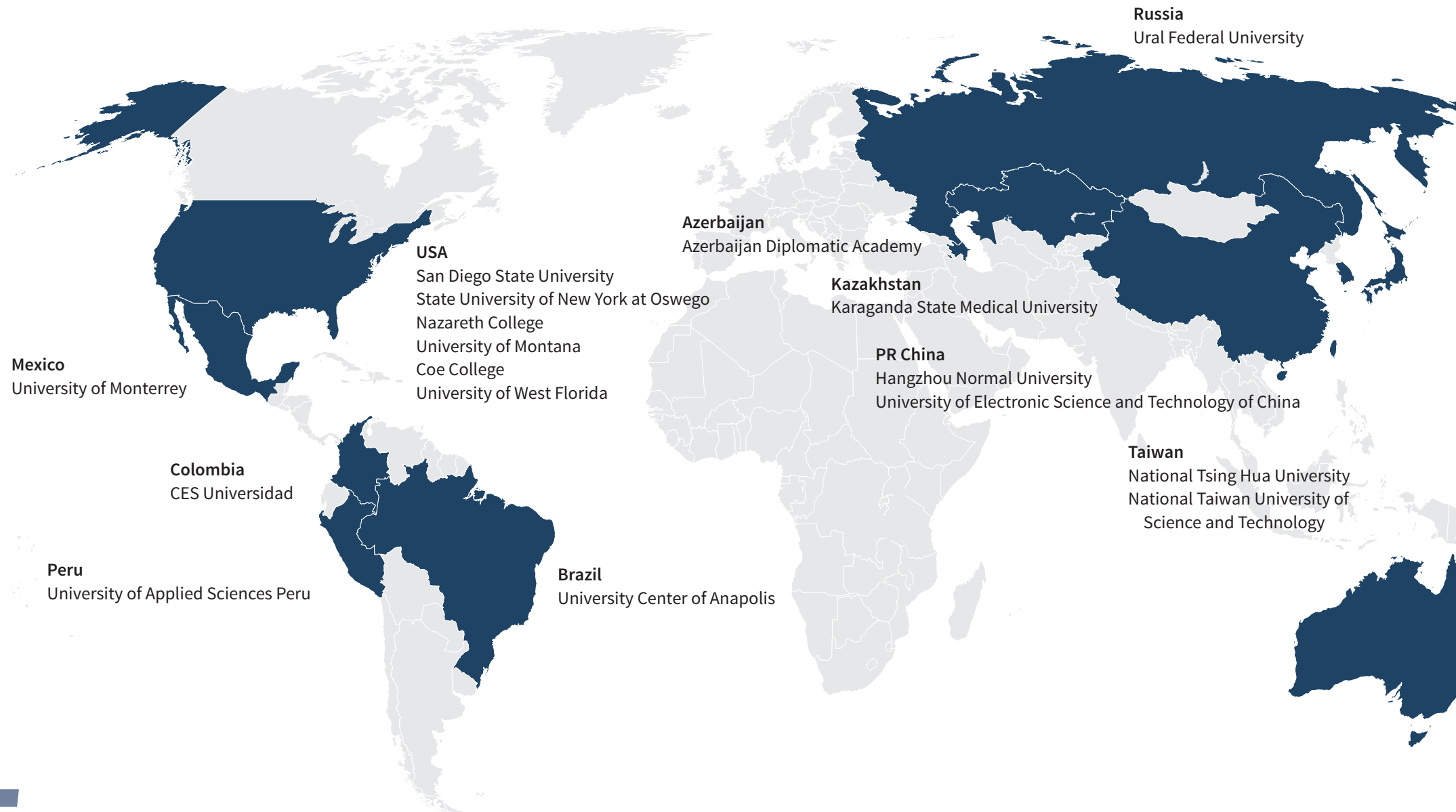

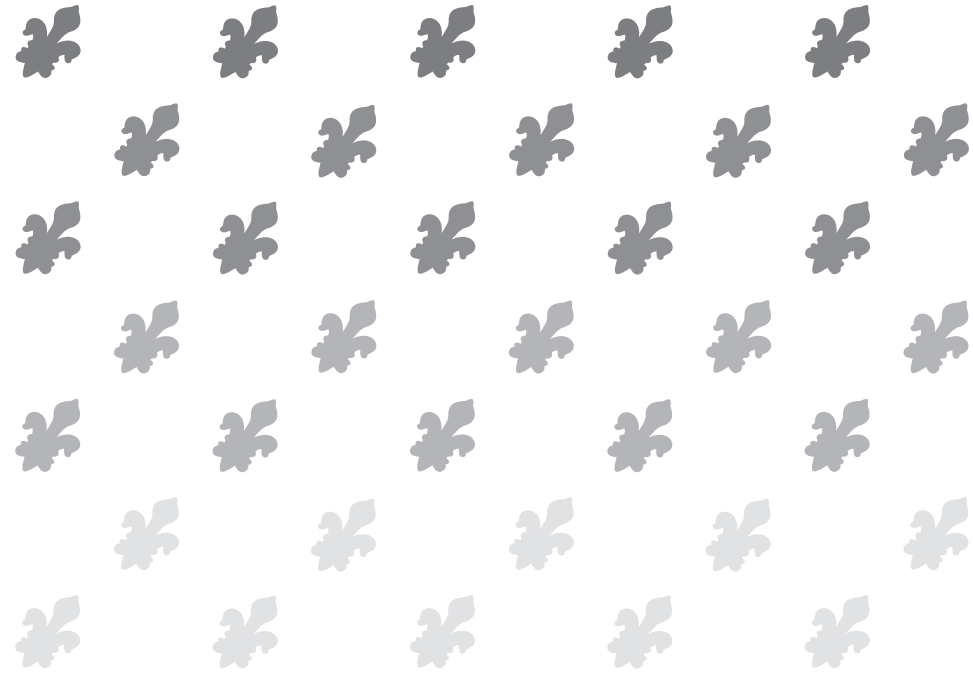

A true City University

In recent years the university has been rapidly developing and internationalising. Students can take advantage of a wide and varied selection of almost 70 programmes covering business, social and natural sciences, IT, engineering and medicine. These are all taught in English, which gives the university its international status. Indeed, there are more than 4,500 foreign students from 114 countries enrolled today.

Prospective learners who cannot commit to a full degree are welcome to visit one of the summer schools or enrol for a semester or two on the various scholarship schemes available. This way, they will still get a taste of Pécs: a small and friendly place to live, but one full of interesting things to see and do thanks to its time as a European Capital of Culture in 2010.

The University of Pécs is located in the uniquely beautiful and lively city of Pécs – a proper, multi-campus university town.

When it opened its doors in 1367, the University of Pécs was the first institution of its kind in Hungary. Over a tumultuous six-and-a-half centuries, it has been dissolved and reopened by various authorities, but the series of modern incarnations has been on-going since 1912.
