Funding and Scholarships

Self-financed international students, registered for a degree program, pay a tuition fee to the University of Pécs. The amount depends on the particular study program and level.


Furthermore, the application fee and registration fee (if there is one) depend on the study program. These two fees are non-refundable. Once transferred and received, the admission boards start the evaluation of the applicant's documents.

Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship

International students have the opportunity to apply for the *Stipendium Hungaricum* Scholarship Program funded by the Hungarian Government. The full-funded scholarship covers the tuition fee, dormitory placement or a monthly contribution to accommodation costs and living expenses and health care services. Residents of countries that have valid/effective bilateral educational work plan agreement signed with Hungary are considered as eligible applicants. More on: stipendiumhungaricum.hu

Erasmus+ Program

One of the most well-known and successful programs of the European Commission which consists of two main academic unities: foreign study visits and internships. The University of Pécs is one of the partner universities and provides opportunities for its self-financed international students to join the European Exchange Program and go to study at another European institution while receiving scholarships from the EU.

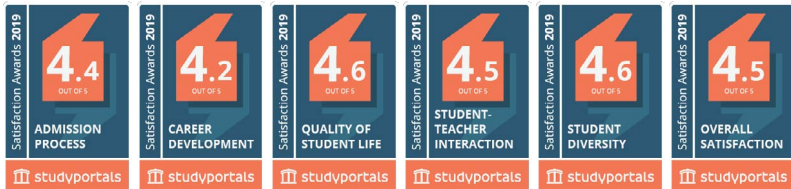

Many students may find it difficult adjusting to life away from home, particularly those who are coming straight from high school and have never lived on their own. For these students, it is recommended they live in the dorms for the first year as they adapt to life in a new place and studying at University. Each first year non-medical student has a guaranteed placement in one of University dormitories. Rooms are offered on a reasonable price level: approximately EUR 130 per month.

Pécs is much smaller than Budapest and has much less nightlife than Miami Beach, but Pécs provides more than enough for students to do. There are cinemas where you can see movies in English or Hungarian, and plenty of bars and restaurants.

Traveling to Budapest for a weekend is always a great idea. You can see the monuments and enjoy the city with friends. Students also enjoy traveling to countries within the region like Croatia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Austria.

Student services

Student Organizations

The Student Council of the University of Pécs (**PTE EHÖK**) is an organization, which deals with students advocacy and protection. They are managing our activities cooperating with each faculty's parth authorities and the leadership of the UP. They are also engaged in program organization, so students can relax during their studies. PTE EHÖK's representatives and officers are elected by the students, which means that every student is a voter or eligible.



Students at all faculties can join **Erasmus Student Network (ESN)**. ESN is represented in 42 countries with over 500 sections and here in Hungary there are 15 sections. The ESN Pécs is the most diverse in Hungary and anyone who wants to get involved with other international students, especially the exchange students should take up the opportunity to work with ESN.



AEGEE is one of Europe's biggest interdisciplinary student organizations, striving for a democratic, diverse and borderless Europe. As a non-governmental, politically independent, and non-profit organization AEGEE is open to students and young people from all faculties and disciplines. Founded in 1985 in Paris, today AEGEE has grown to a Network of 13 000 AEGEEans, present in 161 cities in 40 countries all over Europe.

Admission requirements

In order to be eligible for university studies in Hungary, a prospective student must demonstrate that they meet several requirements for courses or programs. There are certain general entry requirements and documents that all applicants must meet and submit:



Certificate of the previous studies (Secondary school leaving certificate, BA/BSc degree, MA/MSc degree) in English or with official translation



Transcript of previous studies (or academic records) in English or with official translation



Minimum upper-intermediate proficiency in the language of instruction (e.g.: IELTS 5.5, TOEFL iBT 66)



CV in language of instruction





Motivation letter in language of instruction



7 steps towards your future – Application guide

University of Pécs is using an online application process which generates all prospective students' applications through the www.apply.pte.hu website. It takes you just 7 easy steps to start your future academic experience and exciting student life in Pécs:

- 1.** Learn about the available study programs, fees and entrance requirements on www.international.pte.hu/programs
 - 2.** Choose the best program for you, click on “Apply Now” and start your application.
 - 3.** Register on our application site, fill in the form, upload the required documents and submit the application!
 - 4.** After the successful submission, you will receive a Notification for Application fee payment. Transfer the fee via regular bank transfer or pay online via credit card.
 - 5.** Receiving the application fee, the Faculty starts the evaluation of your documents. If eligible, you shall be invited to a Skype interview.
 - 6.** If you succeed on the Skype interview, you receive the Conditional Acceptance Letter and Notification for Tuition fee payment.
 - 7.** Upon receiving the tuition fee, the Faculty will issue you your Final Letter of Acceptance. Congratulations! You can now start arranging your travel to Pécs!

Pécs, the city of many cultures


Pécs, the center of Baranya County, is the fifth largest city in Hungary. It is situated in the south-western part of the country, on the slopes of Mecsek Hills, close to the border with Croatia. Many consider Pécs an important gateway of Europe, linking Western Europe with the Balkans.


While the area has been inhabited for over 6,000 years, the first days of the modern city date back to the 2nd century, when Pécs, then Sopianae, was founded by the Romans. Many cultural layers are woven in the walls of the city which built up a rich history of more than two thousand years making it a part of the UNESCO World Heritage. Through history, Pécs changed its names, but never the historically multi cultured soul. No wonder that it was declared as the European Capital of Culture in 2010 by the European Commission.

The Mediterranean climate, picturesque streets of the historic center, vineyards on the slopes of Mecsek which are sunlit during summer and covered in snow during winter, paint a lively and colorful landscape.

Among the many names that this city carried through time, the present name – **Pécs** – first showed up in formal documents in the year of 1235 as “Pechyut” – with modern spelling: pécsi út, which means “road to/from Pécs”, qualifying the city as a welcoming destination for more and more international students.

Since Pécs is the center of science and education, it is frequently hosting domestic and international conferences and symposia. In terms of entertainment and events, the city offers a respective number of activities, excursions and festivals for everyone, regardless of taste or budget.
