Description: ÉlményTár Tanoda has been working in Pécs since 2010 to promote the welfare and wellbeing of children living in the outskirts of the town. Employing the methods of community work, the organization provides a variety of programmes for these children living in poverty, including recreational and sports programmes. The organization has been a collaborating partner of the Department of Social and Community Studies and has already provided field practice experience for several international students.

They offer daily programmes to improve children's school performance and socialization, thereby reducing dropout and other risks. Programmes include digital skills development, communication skills development, recreations, sports, mentoring and talent development. They are also active in charity work to help those who live in extreme poverty.
