# Erasmus + International Credit Mobility (KA171) programme

International Credit Mobility is funded under Key Action 1 of the Erasmus+ programme, promoting the international exchange of students and staff between higher education institutions in Erasmus+ Programme and Partner Countries.

The University of Pécs as programme country institution is expected to implement 158 individual mobility (incoming/outgoing student and teaching staff) in the 2022-25 project period with 30 partner institutions from 22 countries. Partners are from the following regions: Western Balkan, South Mediterranean, Eastern Partnerships, Russia, Asia, the Caribbean and African regions.

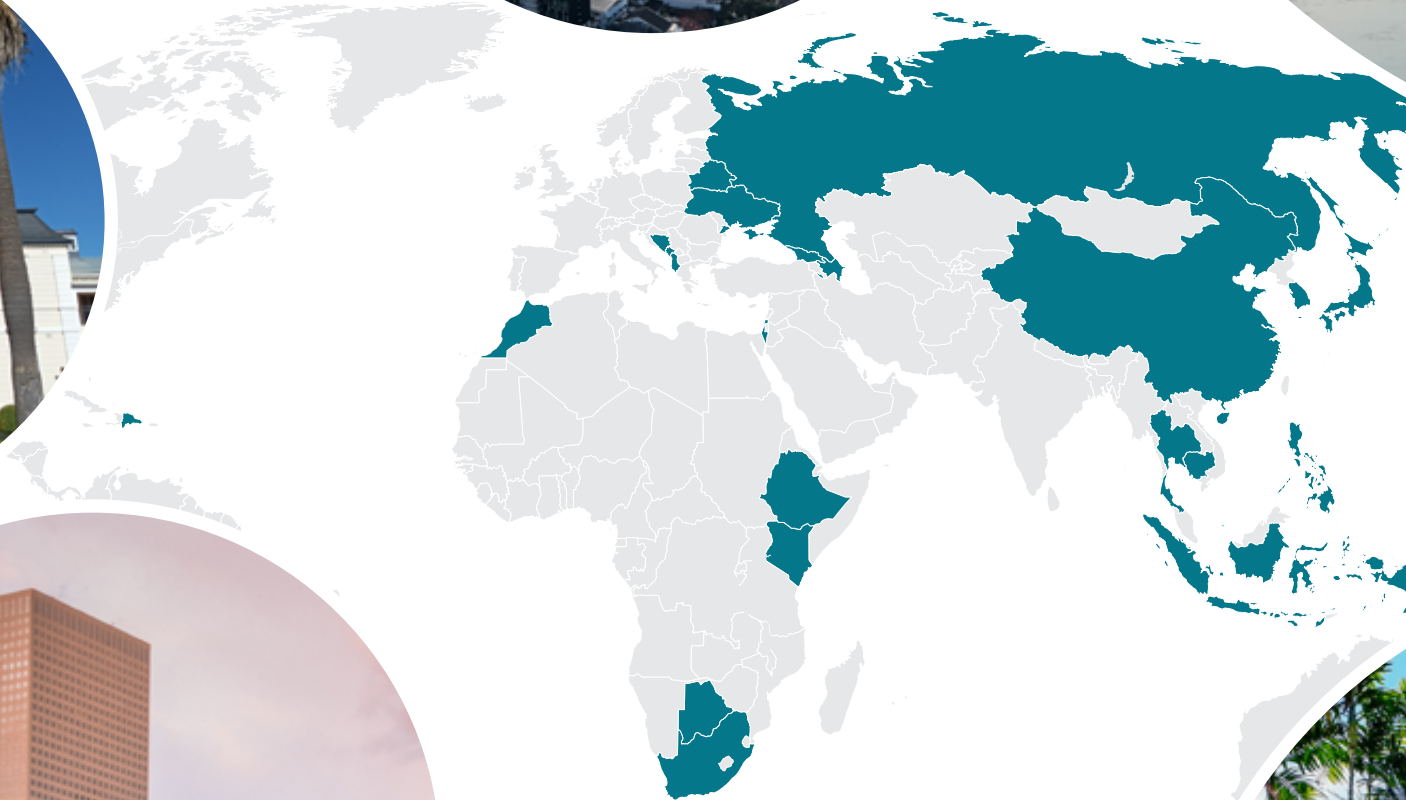


With 30 years of experience in the Erasmus programme the University of Pécs offers fully English taught courses at the following faculties/schools:

In addition, two of my dreams came true in Denver: To experience an American football game as a spectator and to catch trout with fly fishing.



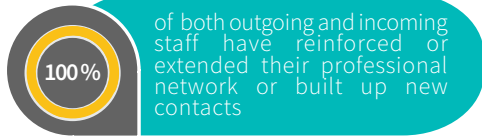
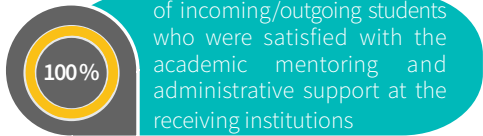
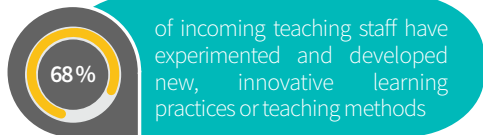
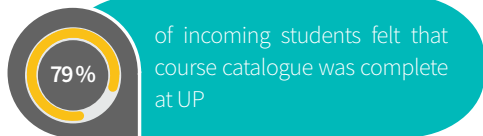
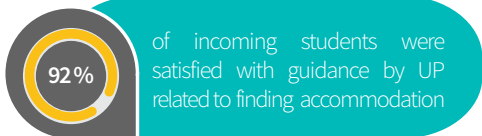
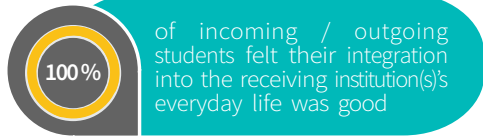
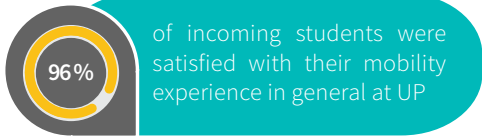

# A True City University



The University of Pécs is located in the uniquely beautiful and lively city of Pécs – a proper, multi-campus university town.

When it opened its doors in 1367, the University of Pécs was the first institution of its kind in Hungary. Over a tumultuous six-and-a-half centuries, it has been dissolved and reopened by various authorities, but the series of modern incarnations has been on-going since 1912.



The university has been rapidly developing and internationalising. Students can take advantage of a wide and varied selection of almost 100 programmes covering business, social and natural sciences, IT, engineering and medicine. These are all taught in English, which gives the university its international status. Indeed, there are more than 4,500 foreign students from 130 countries enrolled today.

Prospective learners who cannot commit to a full degree are welcome to visit one of the summer schools or visit for a semester or two on the various scholarship schemes available. This way, they will still get a taste of Pécs: a small and friendly place to live, but one full of interesting things to do and see thanks to its time as a European Capital of Culture in the year 2010.
