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Erasmus + International Credit Mobility (KA171) programme

International Credit Mobility is funded under Key Action 1 of the Erasmus+ programme, promoting the international exchange of students and staff between higher education institutions in Erasmus+ Programme and Partner Countries.

The University of Pécs as programme country institution is expected to implement 158 individual mobility (incoming/outgoing student and teaching staff) in the 2022-25 project period with 30 partner institutions from 22 countries. Partners are from the following regions: Western Balkan, South Mediterranean, Eastern Partnerships, Russia, Asia, the Caribbean and African regions.

The university has been rapidly developing and internationalising. Students can take advantage of a wide and varied selection of almost 100 programmes covering business, social and natural sciences, IT, engineering and medicine.
