- **UniverCity** – countless cafés, restaurants, nightclubs, bars that will keep you entertained













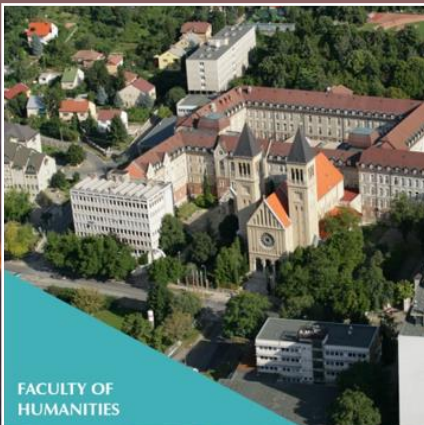
# University of Pécs

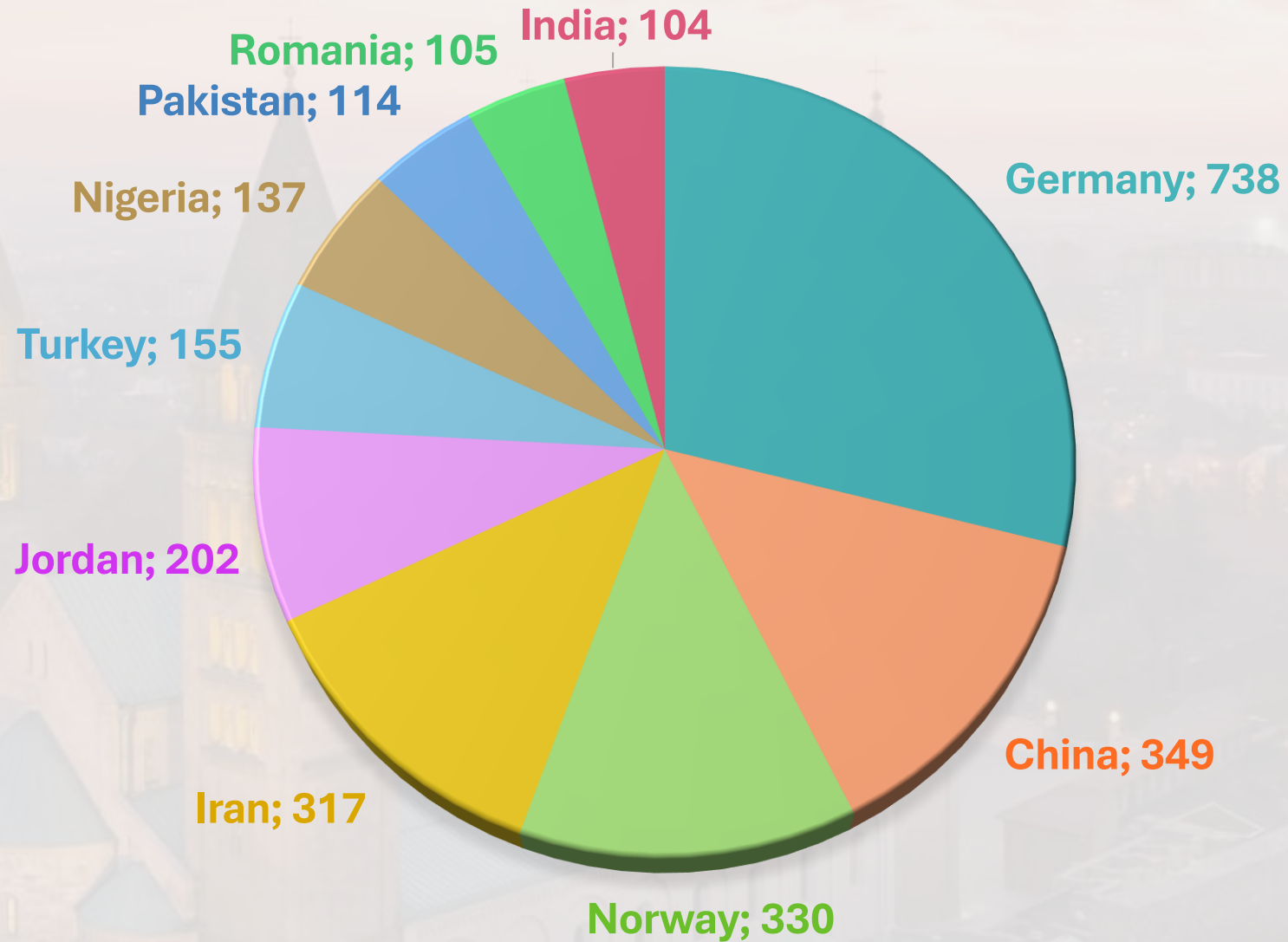
# One of the most internationalized universities
