



APPLICATION NOTICE AND GUIDE

The Medical School of the University of Pécs calls for applications for participating in the Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies in the Academic Year 2023/24

The aim of scholarship:

Funded by the European Union with the goal of improving academic, language and cultural experiences in another program country's higher educational institute for those students who have already obtained a high school diploma and are currently attending a higher education institution. The aim of study visit is to complete a semester, realise a part-time study or write a thesis. The mobility can be realised if the studies abroad are accepted and counted as part of the student's study by the sending institution (for UP credits). Students of the Medical School have to perform do their practices taking into account the syllabi of the rotational year courses, but the assessment will take place at UP MS, which also means the acceptance of the credits corresponding to the internship.

Duration of study mobility abroad: min. 2 months - max. 4 months and 2 weeks

The mobility must take place by: 30.06.2024

Currency of the mobility: HUF

Erasmus+ students studying abroad:

- can spend 2-4 months and 2 weeks abroad (depending on the year they are in and the partner institution);
- do not pay tuition fee at the receiving institution; however may be obliged to pay registration/administration fee (mainly at German universities);
- enrol at the home university, establish an active student status, pay any possible tuition fees due to their home university and receive their grants due for the period of studying abroad;



- do not obtain their degree before ending the mobility;
- can have their studies accomplished abroad counted in their home study requirements (before the student's departure, the two cooperating departments must agree on the courses to be taken up by the student at the receiving university.
- within the framework of studying abroad at the partner university, PhD students can carry out research specified in their training plan.

Who can apply?

General conditions of participation:

- the student must have Hungarian citizenship or must pursue studies aiming at obtaining a degree in the institution;
- Students with Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship cannot apply for Erasmus+
- in the semester the student is planning his/her mobility the student has an active student status at UP; the student cannot obtain his/her degree before ending the mobility;
- the student meets the application requirements announced by the given faculty/department;
- spends 2-12 months abroad (depending on the year and the partner institution);
- more than one destination can be applied for, their ranking must be specified;
- the successful applicant must take the on-line language test OLS (Online Linguistic Support) if the medium of instruction is not his/her mother tongue but one of the following: English, German, Italian, Spanish, French, or Dutch (more detailed information after the favourable evaluation of the application).

According to the rules/regulations of the Erasmus+ Programme each student can obtain Erasmus status for a maximum of 12 months per training level (study abroad and internship in total), thus if the student has already participated in Erasmus study abroad and/or internship, even if as a zero grant (LABEL) student but has not used up the 12-month Erasmus period, he/she can apply again.



Students pursuing master level or doctoral studies who already were Erasmus students at their former training level(s) can also apply.

One travel day before the activity and one travel day after the activity can be covered under the individual support. In the case of students with fewer opportunities, they are entitled to additional support in the amount of HUF 100,000 in addition to their individual support under the EU Erasmus+ program. Equal opportunity support is provided on the basis of a separate application.



Travel support:

Students who choose environmentally friendly/environmentally conscious travel - bus, train or shared car use (with fellow students, not with family/friends) - will receive an one-time contribution of HUF 20,000 as a supplement to the individual support, and if applicable, they will receive a maximum of 4 days of additional individual support to cover travel days related to a return trip.

We draw the attention of the applying students that the scholarship does not cover all the costs incurred during the stay abroad, it must be supplemented from other sources.

Student mobility for study – application procedure:

1. Besides good scholastic record, B2 level language knowledge is also a must. In case of Italy, Spain, France and Portugal language knowledge of the host country is compulsory.
2. Preference will be given to students who carry out research or do significant volunteering activity. Evaluation criteria can be downloaded from our website.
3. Requirement for accepting the completion of a subject is the pre-procedure of credit transfer before travelling abroad.
4. Students must carry out their mobility activity in a Programme Country different from the country of the sending organisation.

Application must include the following documents:

- a copy of any **official language** certificates – (a high school certificate is not an official language certificate)
- **professional CV** (English or German language, depending on the host institutions(s))
- **certificate(s) of scientific and research activities** (please include the number of semesters you have spent performing the activity). Templates for certificates can be downloaded from our website!
- **certificate(s) of volunteering activities** (please include the number of events and the exact time spent (hours) on them). Templates for certificates can be downloaded from our website!
- **Motivation letter** (English language)
- **Current transcript of records**



We cannot accept application materials that are incomplete, do not comply with requirements or are handed in after deadline.

Application deadline: 17.10.2023. 23:59 on the mobility online interface. The faculty coordinator provides more information about the application.

We cannot accept applications that are incomplete, that do not meet the conditions, or that arrive after the deadline.

Assessment of applications:

The applications will be evaluated by the Ad hoc Erasmus Committee. The final decision will be made by the dean of the Faculty. Students who have not previously participated in the Erasmus program will be given priority in course of evaluation. Students who are not awarded a grant but are recommended by the institute/department responsible for the cooperation can participate even in the lack of a grant as self-funded students, so called **label students**, provided they can cover the costs of their travel and stay abroad from other sources.
