



## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

**The Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of Pécs calls for applications for participating in the Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Traineeships in the Academic Year 2023/2024**

### **The aim of the call for applications:**

Student mobility for traineeship is a period spent at an enterprise or an organisation in another programme country. The aim of the placement is to help students acquire competences which are relevant in the EU-wide labour market and to understand the economic and social culture of the host country. The host enterprise may be a private or public organisation active in the field of the labour market or education, training or youth, except for National Agencies and EU bodies.

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ Programme, successful applicants are given the opportunity to do traineeships at the universities, professional organisations and non-profit organisations of the programme countries. The aim of the mobility can be studies relevant to the student's major combined with serving traineeship. **The mobility can only be realised if the sending institution accepts the traineeship accomplished abroad and counts them in the academic progress of the student (by granting UP credits) and/or issuing a Diploma Supplement.**

Students performing abroad within the framework of the Erasmus+ Programme:

- Enroll in the home institution, establish an active student status, pay any possible tuition fees that may be due to their home institution, and obtain their regular grant for the period of their stay abroad.

Duration of the placement mobility: **min. 63 days - max. 90 days (3 months)**

Number of weekly hours of work placement: **min. 30 hours/week**

The period of the internship: **01.03.2024 - 31.07.2024.**

Scholarship currency: **HUF**



### Who can apply?

The following students may apply:

- the student must have Hungarian citizenship or must pursue studies aiming at obtaining a degree in the institution and cannot obtain his/her degree before ending the mobility;
- Students with Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship cannot apply for Erasmus+
- post-degree placements are not possible;
- **in the semester the mobility is performed, the student must have an active student status at UP;**
- the students' language competence is checked in the way requested by the European Commission (on-line survey after selection and after returning home);
- meets the requirements of the Faculty's advertised application requirements

### Documents to be submitted by the applicants:

1. Motivation Letter (approximately 1500 characters)
2. Professional CV
3. Transcript of records (2 previous semesters)
4. Language certificate
5. Official invitation letter from the host company/ institution
6. Certificate of professional or public activities (if any)
7. Professor's Recommendation
8. Letter of Acceptance

According to the rules/regulations of the Erasmus+ Programme each student can obtain Erasmus status for a maximum of 12 months per training level (study abroad and traineeship in total), thus if the student has already participated in Erasmus study abroad and/or traineeship, but has not used up the 12-month Erasmus period, he/she can apply again. Students pursuing master level or doctoral studies who already were Erasmus students at their former training level(s) can also apply.

The amount of the grant depends on the length of the period of traineeship (number of days) and on the host country. The following amounts of grant may presumably be awarded for the academic year 2023/2024 (1 month of mobility means 30 days).

**HUF-BASED SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT**

One travel day before the activity and one travel day after the activity can be covered under the individual support.

In the case of students with fewer opportunities, they are entitled to additional support in the amount of HUF 100,000 in addition to their individual support under the EU Erasmus+ program. Equal opportunity support is provided on the basis of a separate application.

**Travel support:**

Students who choose environmentally friendly/environmentally conscious travel - bus, train or shared car use (with fellow students, not with family/friends) - will receive an one-time contribution of HUF 20,000 as a supplement to the individual support, and if applicable, they will receive a maximum of 4 days of additional individual support to cover travel days related to a return trip.

**We draw the attention of the applying students that the scholarship does not cover all the costs incurred during the stay abroad, it must be supplemented from other sources.**



**Deadline and method of submitting the application:**

**We cannot accept applications that are incomplete, that do not meet the conditions, or that arrive after the deadline.**

**Evaluation of applications submitted:**

Applications submitted are evaluated by a professional board, the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the Faculty formed by the Faculty. The evaluation criteria are stipulated in the order of business of the committee evaluating the applications.

**Procedure for evaluating applications**

(1) Ranking is broken down to receiving institutions and then to language areas.

(2) Each application may be awarded a maximum of 100 points as broken down below:

(a) Language knowledge

(a.1.) A maximum of 25 points may be awarded for language knowledge.

(a.1.) The evaluation of language exams taken in the language of instruction of the receiving institution or in English:

Level of language exam	Points
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State accredited, intermediate, general, type C (complex) language exam	10 points
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State accredited, advanced, general, type C (complex) language exam	20 points
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If the applicant does not have a language exam certificate, it will be decided whether he/she can apply on the basis of a language interview without prejudice to his/her chances.

(a.1.1) Further language exam(s) can be awarded altogether	5 points.
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(b) Academic performance

(b.1.) Academic performance can be awarded a maximum of	20 points.
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**The following activities constitute an advantage at the evaluation:**

- Participating in scientific work
- Community work (Student Union, Student Erasmus/Mentor group etc.)



Under the regulations, German and/or English language interview is conducted as stipulated by the Faculty.

Students who have not participated in the Erasmus Programme before are given priority at the evaluation.
