



APPLICATION NOTICE AND GUIDE

The University of Pécs Faculty of Pharmacy are calling for applications for participating in the Erasmus+ Student Mobility for self-organized traineeships in the Academic Year 2023/2024

The aim of scholarship:

The winner students get the possibility to do practices at the universities of the program countries within the frame of the Erasmus+ program. The aim of the mobility can be a practice combined with the student's study. The foreign practice has to be accepted by the sending institution and included in the student's progress in Hungary (with the number of credits awarded at UP).

Students who fulfil their practices abroad in the frame of the Erasmus+ Program:

- must be enrolled at the University of Pécs Faculty of Pharmacy for the period spent at the receiving university;
- have to pay the normal tuition fee here in Pécs. At the receiving institution there is no tuition fee (though, there might be registration fee at some receiving universities).

Eligible activities:

- higher educational students' traineeship mobility (minimum 2 months)

Duration of mobility abroad: min. 63 days - max. 90 days (3 months)

Number of hours per week of the traineeship: min. 30 hours/week

The mobility must take place between: 01.03.2024- 31.07.2024.

Currency of the grant: HUF



Who can apply for the traineeship?

Terms and conditions:

- applicants should be Hungarian citizens, or students studying at a degree-seeking program of the University of Pécs Faculty of Pharmacy;
- students with Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship cannot apply for Erasmus+ grant
- applicants spend minimum 2 months abroad (depending on the study year, partner university);
- to apply, students must be enrolled at the University of Pécs Faculty of Pharmacy, for the period spent at the receiving university;
- students cannot graduate at the sending institution until completing their Erasmus grant period.

The amount of the grant depends on the length of the study period (number of days) and on the host country. The following amounts of grant may presumably be awarded for the academic year 2023/2024

(1 month of mobility means 30 days).

FORINT-BASED SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT



Students who do not receive travel support can opt for green travel. In this case, they will receive a single contribution of 20.000 HUF as a top-up amount to the individual support and up to 4 days of additional individual support to cover travel days for a return trip, if relevant.

Students with fewer social opportunities can apply for a 100.000 HUF extra grant. The equal opportunities grant is paid on the basis of a separate application.

All applicants are reminded that the grant will not fully cover the cost and expenses of the travel and the stay abroad, therefore additional sources are needed. Successful applicants may have to contribute to these costs and expenses from their own sources in addition to any support the faculty might award.

Student mobility for traineeship – application procedure:

1. Students need to ask a tutor for a written recommendation letter.
2. Traineeship mobilities may be minimum 2 months.
3. Besides good scholastic record, B2 level language knowledge is also a must.

Deadline and procedure of submitting the application:

Application must include the following documents:

- a copy of any **official language certificates** – (a high school certificate is not an official language certificate)
- **professional CV** (English or German language, depending on the host institutions(s))
- **Motivation letter (English language)**
- **Professor's recommendation**
- **Stamped, signed acceptance letter** (can be downloaded from the official website of the Registrar's Office- Professional Practices)



We cannot accept application materials that are incomplete, do not comply with requirements or are handed in after deadline.

Deadline: 15 May 2024 at 3.00 p.m. on Mobility Online surface.

Assessment of applications:

The applications will be evaluated by the Ad hoc Erasmus Committee. The final decision will be made by the Dean.

Students who have not previously participated in the Erasmus program will be given priority in course of evaluation. Students who are not awarded a grant but are recommended by the institute/department responsible for the cooperation can participate even in the lack of a grant as self-funded students, so called **label students**, provided they can cover the costs of their travel and stay abroad from other sources.

Double financing of costs and expenses is prohibited.
