

General informations regarding the green form of travel:

- Trains, buses, carpools, bicycles, or other sustainable means (NOT ships and airplanes) can be considered green travel.
- The green travel support can only be given if the majority of the trip is made with a sustainable means.
- The green travel support is NOT applicable if the green travel is only carried out in one direction.
- You can verify the travel with the **travel tickets**, or in the absence of this (e.g. in the case of traveling by carpooling), with the **criminal declaration**.
- · In case of a carpooling, traveling with family/friends is not considered as green travel

The amount of green travel support:

- · If students choose green travel, they are entitled to a one-time travel grant of € 50 / HUF 20,000, as well as a subsistence allowance for a maximum of 4 additional travel days.
- Students traveling for short mobility and recent graduates can receive support for a maximum of 2 travel days.
- Judging the number of green travel days is the responsibility of the institution!

<u>Documents to be submitted when using green travel:</u>

- Declaration about travel
- Criminal declaration (in case of carpooling)
- · Round trip tickets! (repayment is mandatory in the absence of tickets)
