

Call for application

The University of Pécs Medical School calls for applications for participating in the Pannónia Scholarship Program Student Mobility for Traineeship for the autumn semester of the academic year 2026/2027

The object of the call for applications:

The purpose of the call is to offer traineeships at companies or organizations in another program country, lasting a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 months. The aim is to assist in acquiring the skills necessary in the community labor market and to understand the economic and social culture of the host country. Within the framework of the Pannonia Scholarship Program, successful applicants have the opportunity to complete traineeships at universities, teaching hospitals, and other accredited practice places in the program country. The mobility can only take place if the foreign traineeship is accepted by the sending institution and credited to the student's progress at the Faculty. The traineeship shall only be accepted if the practice place complies with the rules of accreditation of the Faculty.

Duration of traineeship: min. 2 months (62 days) – max. 4 months (120 days)

Period of traineeship: from 01/07/2026

Currency of the scholarship: **HUF**

Scholarship financing: 90% pre-10% post-financing (after submission of the mandatory documentation)

Working hours: minimum 30 working hours/week. Please take into account the total number of hours required for your compulsory practical training in all cases.

Pannónia Scholarship Program students studying abroad:

- spend 2-4 months abroad (min. 62 days)

- enroll at the University of Pécs Medical School, establish an active student status, pay any applicable tuition fees to their home university, and receive their grants for the period of studying abroad;
- do not obtain their degree at the Medical School before ending the mobility;

Other information:

- The Medical School guarantees students 100% recognition of internship abroad, provided that the conditions for the recognition are fully met.
- 100% recognition of the internship completed abroad can be guaranteed if the practice place applied by the student complies with the Faculty's accreditation rules, and if the requirements set out in the course description of the practice are fully met.
- When applying, **General Medicine students** must submit a certificate from the Faculty's Registrar's Office confirming that the applied practice place complies with the Faculty's accreditation rules. Without this document, the application will be rejected.
- When applying, **Dentistry/Biotechnology students** must submit a supporting statement from the course director of the practice for acceptance of the internship applied. Without this document, the application will be rejected.
- The conclusion of the Support Agreement is only possible if there is a Learning Agreement signed by all three parties. Completion and compliance with the courses agreed in the Learning Agreement is binding for both the student and the institutions.

We would like to draw your attention to the fact that mobility cannot be started without a signed and faculty-approved Learning Agreement, the decision of the Committee on International Affairs at the University of Pécs Medical School, and the signed grant agreement. The university will not transfer funds after the start date of the mobility if the above-mentioned conditions are not met.

Who can apply?

General participation conditions:

- the student is pursuing undergraduate or doctoral studies aimed at obtaining a diploma at the institution;
- the student has min. **1 completed active semester** at the time of application;
- in the semester in which the mobility takes place, **the student has an active student status at the Faculty**; and **do not obtain their degree before the end of the mobility period**;
- the student has a high communication level of English and/or language competences corresponding to the native language of the destination country (minimum B2 but recommended C1);
- the student is allowed to participate in a study mobility period for a maximum of 12 months per academic cycle, regardless of the number or type of mobility activities
- students, who have already participated in an Erasmus+ study or traineeship mobility before, can also apply
- meets the application requirements announced by the given faculty.
- Students with Stipendium Hungaricum/cöf/diaspora scholarship cannot apply!

We cannot support your mobility in case you are in the semester of your graduation, if you do not complete it by 16 March 2026!

Required documents to be submitted:

- **Motivation letter** (approximately 1500 characters)
- **Professional CV**
- **A copy of any official language certificates** – (a high school certificate is not an official language certificate)
- **Transcript of records from, from the previous 2 completed semesters;**

- **Professor's recommendation letter**
- **Stamped, signed acceptance letter** (can be downloaded from the official website of the Registrar's Office- Professional Practices)
- **Certificate issued by the Faculty Registrar's Office**, stating that the practice place applied by the student complies with the Faculty's accreditation rules (only in case of General Medicine students)

OR

- **Written statement issued by the course director of the practice**, stating that the practice place applied by the student can be accepted (only in case of Dentistry/Biotechnology students)

Optional documents to be submitted:

- **certificate(s) of scientific and research activities** (please include the number of semesters you have spent performing the activity).
- **certificate(s) of volunteering activities** (please include the number of events and the exact time spent (hours) on them).

Grants for the academic year 2026/2027:

Amount of the grant depends on the length of the study period (number of days) and on the host country.

We draw the attention of the applying students that the scholarship does not cover all the costs incurred during the mobility, it must be supplemented from other sources!

Under the general mobility program, students participating in partial mobility training are eligible for travel support if the destination of their mobility is more than 2,000 km away. In this case, based on RVÉ Decision 2025.11.13. Based on the table below, travel support may be granted based on an institutional decision.
