



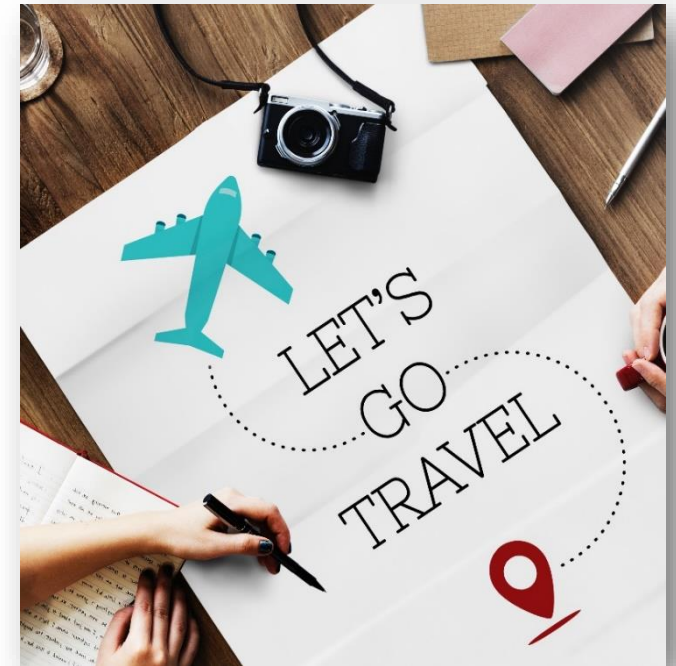

- max. 12 months/study cycle
- Based on Erasmus+ bilateral agreements
- According to study cycle and subject area

- Credit recognition
- 420-520 euro/month

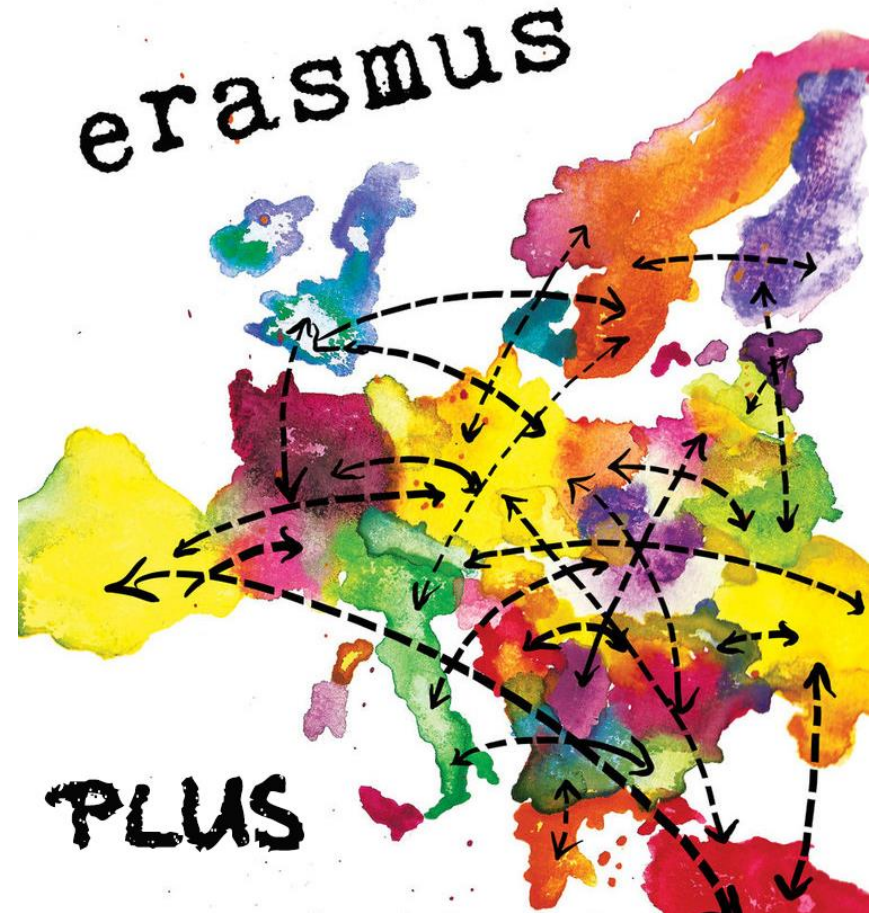

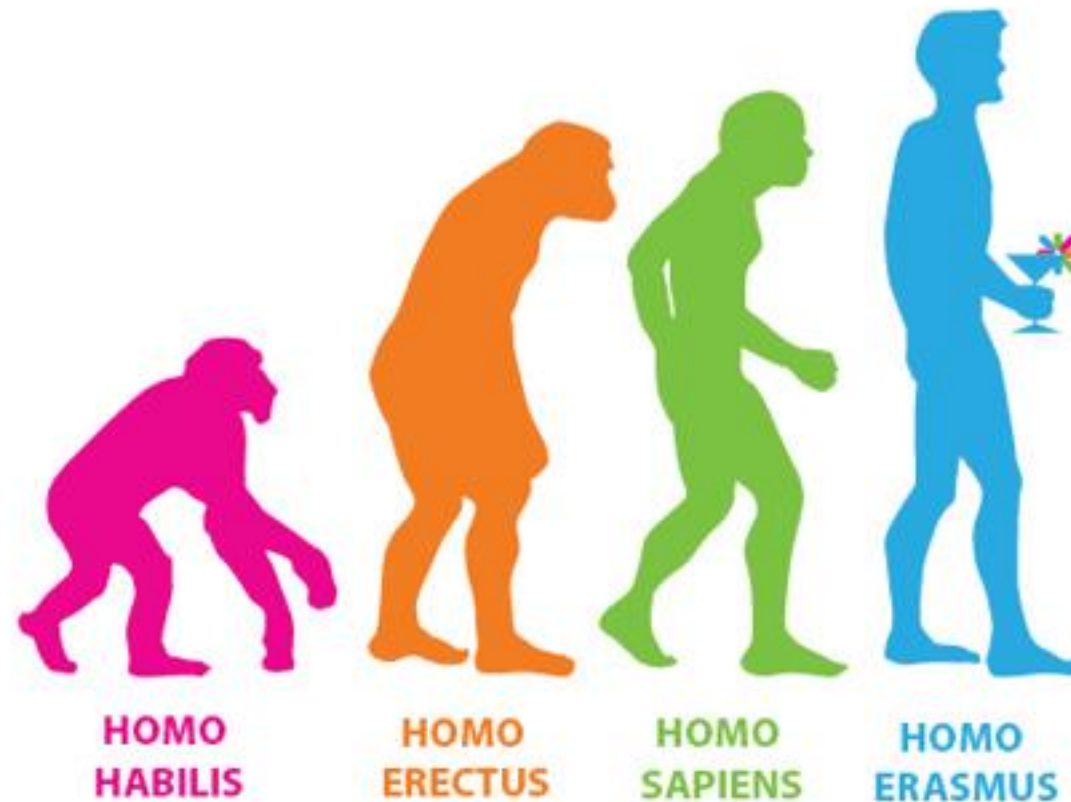

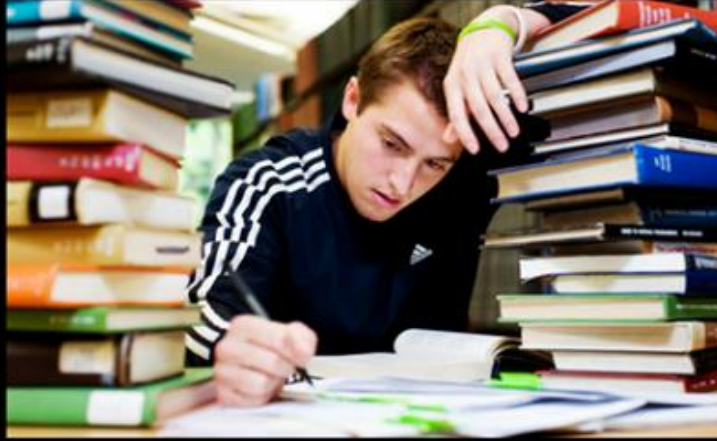
